## Rules of the Painting and Drawing Contest “Traveling Together on the LRT”

### 1. Organizer

### 3. Contest Objective

The LRT, like a dynamic bond weaving through the city, is not only an indispensable part of Macau’s public transport system, but also a green driving force supporting citizen’s daily journeys. Flowing across the city, it keeps pace with its heartbeat, sketching beautiful scenes of shared growth and progress.

Under the theme “Traveling Together”, this contest warmly invites Macau’s primary and secondary school students, as well as the general public, to unleash their imagination through painting, contributing to a more vibrant and welcoming travel environment.

### 4. Contest Theme

“Traveling Together on the LRT”

### 5. Target Participants and Categories

Elementary Primary School Category: students from the 1st to the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of primary education✳

Complementary Primary School Category: students from the 4th to the 6th year of primary education✳

Secondary School Category: students from the 1st year of general secondary education to the 3rd year of complementary secondary education✳

Public Category: Macau residents aged 16 or above (those who have reached 16 years of age by June 30, 2026)

✳ Note: applicable to holders of a valid student card issued by the Education and Youth Development Bureau.

## 6. Requirements for the Works

### 6.1 Painting of the Works / Drawing Requirements

Secondary School Category	<p>The works must be hand-drawn, and materials such as watercolors, acrylics, colored pencils, or pastels may be used, provided they are resistant to fading;</p> <p>Works created by computer or through digital synthesis will not be accepted.</p>	A3 size (29.7 cm × 42 cm), paper type is free.

6.2 The three painting templates can be downloaded from the MLM website (<https://www.mlm.com.mo/en/paintContest.html>) and printed on A4 paper. The organizer provides three templates respectively for the Elementary

Primary School Category and the Complementary Primary School Category. Participants may choose one template and paint it with any type of paint. They may also create freely in the blank spaces to express content related to the contest theme.

6.3 Works created by computer or through digital synthesis will not be accepted.

6.4 Participants must include in the registration form a written explanation of no more than 50 words, describing the creative idea or story related to the work.

6.5 The front side of the work must not contain any information or identifying marks, such as name, school name, etc.

## 7. Contest Prizes and Exhibition

In each category, there will be 3 first prizes, 5 second prizes, 8 third prizes, and merit awards.

1st Prize: certificate and MOP 1,200

2nd Prize: certificate and MOP 800

3rd Prize: certificate and MOP 500

Merit Award: souvenir.

\* The award-winning works will be publicly exhibited.

## 8. Contest Rules

8.1 The works submitted must be original and may not be copied from third-party works, nor created by computer or through digital synthesis (AI). Offenders will be disqualified, required to return monetary prizes and certificates, and will bear full legal responsibility;

8.2 Participants must correctly and clearly complete all information in the registration form. Omissions or false information will result in disqualification by the organizer;

8.3 Each participant may register in only one contest category and submit one

work. In the case of multiple submissions, only the last submitted work will be considered for evaluation;

- 8.4 The works submitted must not have been published, publicly exhibited, nor have participated in or won prizes in contests in Macau or elsewhere.
- 8.5 The works must not contain violent, pornographic, vulgar, obscene, indecent, offensive, controversial, or inappropriate elements. Otherwise, the organizer has the right to disqualify the participant.
- 8.6 Participants agree and authorize the organizer to process their personal data for the purposes of this contest, including but not limited to contest management, statistics, and database creation. The organizer will process the data in accordance with Law No. 8/2005 (Personal Data Protection Law).
- 8.7 By submitting the work, regardless of winning or not, the participant is deemed to have understood and accepted all contest terms. The copyright of the work belongs to the author, who agrees to grant the organizer the permanent and free right to use the work. The organizer may, as necessary, use the work in whole or in part, at any time and in any place, for promotional purposes, reserving the right to reproduce, modify, edit, print, distribute, publish, publicly display, promote, transform into souvenirs, or use for other purposes, without prior consent of the participant or payment of any fee.
- 8.8 The participant agrees that their image, work, and name may be disclosed by the organizer through any promotional channel or publication.
- 8.9 By submitting the work, regardless of winning or not, the participant is deemed to have understood and accepted all contest terms.
- 8.10 The organizer reserves the right to final interpretation and decision regarding this contest. For any omissions, the organizer reserves the right to adjust the content at any time.

## 9. Method and Place of Submission

Online and in-person submissions are accepted. Submissions by mail are not accepted.

- **Online Submission**

Access the website of Macao Light Rapid Transit Corporation, S.A. by 30 June 2026, download the contest rules, click the registration link (<https://www.mlm.com.mo/en/paintContest.html>), complete the form, and upload an image of the work (image size not exceeding 3MB).

- **In-Person Submission**

Submit the completed registration form (downloadable from the website of Macao Light Rapid Transit Corporation, S.A.) together with the work, inside a sealed envelope (the work must not be folded), by the submission deadline, at the designated location and during the following hours:

## 11. Evaluation and Judging Process

- **First Phase (Initial Evaluation):** Selection of admitted contestants in each category.
- **Second Phase (Final Evaluation):** Assessment of the works admitted in the First Phase to award the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes, as well as the merit awards in each category.
- **Jury:** Composed jointly by the organizer and the co-organizer.

## 12. Evaluation and Selection Criteria

Elementary Primary and Complementary Primary Categories:

Creativity (30%), overall aesthetics (30%), theme expression and integrity (40%).

Secondary School and Public Categories:

Creativity (30%), overall aesthetics (30%), relevance to the theme (40%).

## 13. Works Admitted in the First Phase and Submission of Originals

Participants who submitted the works online and are selected for the First Phase must, within the deadline indicated by the organizer, deliver the original work at the following location:
